Citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina are not recommended to travel to Palestine, especially to the Gaza Strip. There have been no conflicts in the West Bank so far, but it is still recommended not to travel to the West Bank unless absolutely necessary. Citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina who are in this country can, in case of need, contact the embassies of Bosnia and Herzegovina in Amman (Jordan) or Cairo (Egypt), with the given details of name and surname, address of residence in BiH, BiH travel document number, and place of residence in Palestine, as well as with the necessary contact information, in order to find a way to provide support.
